Commission that we raise from the sale of books will be donated to the Angel Academy, a school in Katmandu, Nepal. This school is supported by our Prep School and we have recently begun a pen pal programme with 15 orphans who attend the Angel Academy.

On Wednesday 22 May, parents are invited to the Prep Library from 8.45am to 9.45am for morning tea to browse the books at their leisure and to make purchases. Other viewing times for parents are Tuesday 21 May and Wednesday 22 May after school from 3.15- 4.00pm.

Boys will bring home a wish list with details of the books they would like to purchase along with a letter explaining the order process. Books can be paid for by credit card or a cheque made out to Scholastic Australia and marked with your son's name and class on the back. No cash payments will be accepted.

Payment should be sent with the order form in an envelope to your son's class teacher.

**Knick-knacks: These are small items such as fancy pencils, rubbers, sharpeners, posters etc and they can be bought at lunchtime for a few dollars. Boys are asked not to bring lots of money, but just a small amount to buy one or two items. They are usually very popular.
